#### Location

Participants may use the coaching rooms for practice during lunch and break times. We also have access to 1 additional piano practice room. Overnight participants may practice in their rooms in Blackstone Hall.

# **Overnight**

Overnight participants will stay in Blackstone Hall on the Clark campus. These suite-style rooms are air-conditioned and have shared kitchenettes and bathrooms. Pillows are provided but **you need to bring linens as well as as any pots and utensils for use in the kitchen.**
